The seven (7) member Waterways Advisory Committee typically meets at 3:00 p.m. on the fourth Monday of February, March, July and October, and serves in an advisory capacity to the Board of Commissioners. The Committee helps provide direction on issues relating to waterway maintenance and improvement in Ada County. This volunteer position is for a term of three (3) years, and committee members must live in Ada County during their entire term.

Individuals interested in serving on this board are asked to complete a volunteer board application, available at the Ada County Commissioners' Office or on the Web.
