I. IN THE MATTER OF CALL TO ORDER:

Commissioner Rick Yzaguirre called the hearing to order at 3:00 p.m.

II. IN THE MATTER OF NEW BUSINESS:

1. Swearing in of Ada County Commissioners

- Jim Tibbs, Commissioner
