The Ada County Development Services Department is in the process of updating its local Floodplain Hazard Overlay District ordinance governing development within the FEMA designated floodplain. A public open house is scheduled for **Thursday, June 19, 2014 from 3:00 – 8:00 pm** at the Ada County Courthouse. Property owners or development professionals living or working within the unincorporated Ada County floodplain are encouraged to attend. The purpose of the proposed ordinance is to clarify the application process and permitting requirements for development within the floodplain. The local floodplain ordinance can play a role in reducing the amount of floodplain insurance premiums paid by homeowners.
