Re: Presentation of the Communities in Motion 2040 Final Draft

Communities in Motion (CIM) 2035 is the current long range transportation plan for COMPASS, Ada County's Metropolitan Planning Organization and is required in order for COMPASS to receive federal transportation funding. The plan must be updated every 4 years and the next update needs to be adopted by the COMPASS Board no later than September 2014, to ensure funding is not interrupted.

COMPASS has released the final draft of CIM 2040 and is presently accepting public comments until April 27, 2014. In addition to comment on the draft plan as a whole, COMPASS is also looking for feedback on the following:

- The overall goals established for the plan.
- The Communities in Motion 2040 Vision – a description of, and vision for, future growth in the two-county area.
- How to measure the region's progress toward meeting plan goals and realizing the Communities in Motion 2040 Vision.
- How to spend our limited transportation dollars.
- Future transportation priorities, should additional funding become available.
