

RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINDINGS AND ORDER RELATING TO THE PETITION FOR FORMATION OF THE KUNA RECREATION DISTRICT

At a meeting of the Board of Ada County Commissioners (Board), State of Idaho, on the 3rd day of March, 2015, the following Resolution was adopted, to-wit:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-4304, requires that a petition to form a recreation district be filed with the clerk of the board of county commissioners;

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-4304 requires a board of county commissioners to find that such a petition substantially complies with the requirements of Idaho Code § 31-4304;

WHEREAS, upon a finding that such a petition substantially complies with the requirements of Idaho Code § 31-4304, said Idaho Code Section states that the Board shall enter an order to that effect and call for an election;

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-4304 requires a petition to: 1. Be filed with the clerk; 2. Clearly designate the boundaries of the proposed district; 3. State the name of the proposed district; 4. State the maximum tax rate to be imposed upon taxable property within the district; 5. Be signed by not less than 20% of the qualified electors resident in the boundaries of the proposed district; 6. Boundaries of the proposed district include contiguous territory having a market value for assessment purposes of not less than \$5,000,000; 7. Proposed district does not include any area already included in an existing recreational district; 8. Petition includes a map of the proposed district; and 9. Clerk has estimated the cost of advertising and holding the election and the petitioners have paid such estimated cost in cash;

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners (Board) makes the following findings in connection with a petition to form the Kuna Recreation District (District) as follows:

FINDING #1: The Board finds that the Ada County Clerk (Clerk) received a petition (Petition) to form the District on January 26, 2015.

FINDING #2: The Board finds that the Petition contains a legal description of the District boundaries which description clearly designates the boundaries of the proposed district.

FINDING #3: The Board finds that the Petition states the name of the proposed district as the “Kuna Recreation District.”

FINDING #4: The Board finds that the Petition states the maximum tax rate that would be imposed upon taxable property within the District is .00136582.

FINDING #5: The Board finds that the Clerk determined that there are 10,385 qualified electors residing within the proposed district boundaries contained within Ada County and

that the Petition contains 2,385 valid signatures which number of signatures is not less than 20% of the qualified electors residing within the Ada County boundaries of the proposed district.

FINDING #6: The Board finds that the boundaries of the proposed district include contiguous territory within Ada County having an assessed market value of approximately \$988,940,915, which value is not less than five million dollars (\$5,000,000).

FINDING #7: The Board finds that the boundaries of the proposed district do not include any area already within an existing recreation district.

FINDING #8: The Board finds that the Petition includes a map of the proposed district.

FINDING #9: The Board finds that the Clerk estimated the cost of advertising and holding an election to form the District and notified the petitioners of such cost and the Clerk received payment for the estimated amount on February 11, 2015.

WHEREAS, based on the above findings the Board finds that the Petition substantially complies with the requirements of Idaho Code § 31-4304.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Petition substantially complies with Idaho Code § 31-4304 and the Board calls for the election, subject to Idaho Code § 34-106, upon the formation of the proposed Kuna Recreation District.
