

RESOLUTION FOR SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT FOR SOFTWARE AND SERVICES FOR RECORDS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR ACCESS FOR THE 2015-2016 FISCAL YEAR

At a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Ada County Emergency Medical Services District (“Board”), County of Ada, State of Idaho, on this 6th day of October, 2015, the following resolution was adopted as follows, to wit:

WHEREAS, the Board procured an expanded records management system to accommodate the Ada County City Emergency Services System created by a Joint Powers Agreement (hereinafter “ACCESS”); and

WHEREAS, the Board entered into a contract with ESO Solutions, Inc. (“ESO”) for records management software and services for the Ada County Emergency Medical Services District in 2008 (Agreement No. 8267 and Addendum No. 8267-1-08, collectively referred to as “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, said Agreement has been renewed annually upon the adoption by the Board of Ada County Commissioners of the Ada County budget and is currently in force; and

WHEREAS, based upon the review of information provided by the staff of Ada County Emergency Medical Services, there is no other records management system that is compatible with existing interfaces to the management programs, including the CAD system and the billing system currently in use by the Ada County Emergency Medical Services District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code § 67-2808(2)(a), the Board is permitted to use sole source procurement where there is only one vendor or source reasonably available and where the compatibility of equipment, components, accessories, computer software, replacement parts or service is the paramount consideration; and

WHEREAS, further, pursuant to Idaho Code § 67-2808(2)(a), the Board is permitted to use sole source procurement where competitive solicitation is impractical, disadvantageous or unreasonable under the circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board declares that ESO is the sole vendor of a records management system that is compatible or interfaces with the management programs currently in use by the Ada County Emergency Medical Services District, and

therefore, competitive solicitation is unreasonable under the circumstances. Accordingly, by entering into Agreement for the purchase of the below-described software and services, whose term will not exceed one (1) year, the Board does intend to procure the following:

One (1) ePCR Suite w/Quality Management 30,000 - 45,000 Incidents

One (1) Fire Suite 30,000 - 45,000 Incidents

Forty (40) ePCR Mobile

One (1) Interface – Monitor

Three (3) Services – Training

One (1) Services – Training Travel Costs

The Board shall publish notice of this sole source procurement in The Idaho Statesman at least fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the award of any contract to EOS.
