

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF OUT OF COUNTY WASTE

At a meeting of the Board of Ada County Commissioners, State of Idaho, on the 19th day of November, 2015, the following Resolution was adopted, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners, through its Operations Department, operates a municipal solid waste landfill at the Hidden Hollow site; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners, has created a solid waste disposal system based on the needs of unincorporated Ada County and the Cities of Meridian, Eagle, Boise, Garden City, Kuna and Star (the Participating Cities); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners has adopted rules and regulations for the Ada County Solid Waste System restricting receipt of municipal solid waste to only that generated within the confines of Ada County and received from Ada County's the Participating Cities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners has been informed that Idaho Waste Systems operates a municipal solid waste landfill in Elmore County and has suffered a fire in the fill area causing temporary closure; and

WHEREAS, the counties of Elmore and Boise, and the City of Kuna have authorized transportation of municipal solid waste to the Idaho Waste Systems landfill; and

WHEREAS, the counties of Elmore and Boise, and the City of Kuna have requested the Board of Ada County Commissioners to temporarily allow transportation of municipal solid waste generated in those local governmental areas to the Hidden Hollow site; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kuna is a Participating City and is authorized to dispose of municipal solid waste at the Hidden Hollow Site in accordance with the rules applicable to Participating Cities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners have determined that they would like to assist the two adjacent counties with their emergency solid waste disposal issue; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners have determined that accepting waste from these three local governments on a temporary basis will not harm the Ada County ratepayers or the local governments.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Director of the Ada County Operations be, and is hereby, authorized to accept municipal solid waste from the Counties of Elmore and Boise for a period of time not to exceed six months;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tipping fee for non-participating local governments be set at \$33/ton; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the preliminary authorization provided to the Director of Operations on November 18, 2015, be, and is hereby, ratified.
