

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING OWNERSHIP OF ROOK
FOR SERVICE AS A K-9 UNIT**

At a meeting of the Board of county Commissioners, County of Ada, State of Idaho, on this 22nd day of December, 2015, the following resolution was adopted as follows:

WHEREAS, Sheriff Bartlett is expanding his successful K-9 program to include the addition of a new K-9 Unit to be trained as a dual purpose detection and apprehension dog; and

WHEREAS, Morgan Case, the owner of a German Shephard Dog (“GSD”) named Rook (as more particularly described below), has generously donated Rook to the citizens of Ada County for service as a K-9 Unit in the Ada County Sheriff’s Office.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the authority of Section 31-807, Idaho Code, the Board of Ada County Commissioners does hereby find that it is in the public interest to accept ownership of Rook, a male GSD (f.k.a. Zeus) with the DOB of 03/17/2008, Tattoo No: K-A 6936, and Passport No: DE-02-0628459, and place him onto the rolls of property owned by Ada County. Said K-9 Unit shall be used by the Ada County Sheriff’s office until disposed of in accordance with Idaho law.
