

RESOLUTION FOR THE SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT OF ATIA INTERFACE TO CONNECT ADA COUNTY'S RADIO SYSTEM MONITORING SOFTWARE TO ITS 700 MHz ASTRO 25 TRUNKED RADIO NETWORK

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, County of Ada, State of Idaho, on this 14th day of June, 2016, the following resolution was adopted as follows, to wit:

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners is charged by Idaho Code Title 31, Chapter 48 to operate the consolidated Ada County Emergency Communications Center as the consolidated emergency communications system for all public safety entities operated by the cities, fire districts, ambulance districts and Ada County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 67-2808(2)(ii), the Board of Ada County Commissioners is permitted to use sole source procurement where there is only one (1) source reasonably available and where the compatibility of equipment, components, accessories, computer software, replacement parts or service is the paramount consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Ada County Emergency Communications Center currently employs a Motorola 700MHz Astro 25 Trunked Radio System (the "Radio System"); and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2015, Ada County purchased The Genesis Group's GenWatch3-ATIA radio system monitoring software ("Genesis") through Agreement No. 11463; and

WHEREAS, the compatibility between the Radio System and Genesis is of utmost importance to allow for the seamless exchange of information; and

WHEREAS, compatibility between the Radio System and Genesis may only be obtained through interfacing between the two systems; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 67-2808(2)(v), the Board of Ada County Commissioners is permitted to use sole source procurement for the purchase of property for which it is determined there is no functional equivalent; and

WHEREAS, an Air Traffic Information Access ("ATIA") interface created by Motorola is the only interface available to obtain compatibility between the Radio System and Genesis; and

WHEREAS, an ATIA interface created by Motorola has no functional equivalent, as outlined in a letter from Motorola Solutions dated June 3, 2016 (Exhibit A attached); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners desires to purchase the ATIA interface and related services from Motorola; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners has obligated funds from the Emergency Communications Fund and the Ada County Budget for the ATIA interface;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Ada County Commissioners hereby intends to contract for the purchase of an ATIA interface from Motorola Solutions pursuant to the above findings.
