

RESOLUTION FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF CIVIL DEFENSE SUPPLIES

At a meeting of the Board of Ada County Commissioners, State of Idaho, on the 16th day of August, 2016, the following Resolution was adopted to wit:

WHEREAS, Ada County Emergency Management has in storage at a hangar at Glider Park adjoining the Ada County Landfill old Civil Defense supplies, including but not limited to approximately 400 sanitation kits, water barrels, public awareness brochures, and wool blankets; and

WHEREAS, those items were donated to the County at various times in the 1960's and the 1970's, are no longer necessary for county use; and

WHEREAS, any effort to fully itemize the supplies for a potential auction of the items would be very time consuming and present a potential health hazard, considering the dirty and degraded condition of the items and their exposure to rodent feces; and

WHEREAS, donation of the items to an organization other than to entities as described in Idaho Code § 31-808(9) is not permitted; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the items should be disposed of by burying them in the Ada County landfill.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Board of Ada County Commissioners does hereby find that it is in the best interest of the County to dispose of the old Civil Defense supplies as aforementioned, as soon as practicable, and without further notice.
