

EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (ERAP)



Have you been financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic? Do you need help with rent and utilities?

The Boise City / Ada County Housing Authorities' **Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)** helps eligible households in Boise and Ada County who have been financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. The program provides payment assistance for renters behind on rent and utilities, or at risk of becoming behind.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE

Household must have experienced a hardship directly or indirectly related to COVID-19. Eligible expenses are unpaid utilities and unpaid rent or a foreseeable hardship in paying rent. You must also meet income requirements—household income at or below 80% Area Median Income (AMI).
