PRIMARY ELECTION ADA COUNTY ELECTION GUIDE




Primary elections are held to select party candidates for federal, state and county offices. They are held in even-numbered years on the third Tuesday in May. Candidates who receive the most votes during the primary election go on to run in the general election. Your party choice can affect which primary election races you are eligible to vote in.

- 3/29 - Candidate Withdrawal deadline
- 4/26 - Preregistration deadline
- 5/6 - Early voting begins
- 5/10 - Absentee Ballot application deadline
- 5/16 - Voting tabulation equipment test (L&A)
- 5/17 - Early voting ends

ELECTION DAY

Polling locations are open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 21, 2024. If you are **in line before 8:00 p.m., you can still vote.**



VOTE EARLY

Visit an early voting location Mon - Fri from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., **May 6 - May 17.**



VOTE ABSENTEE

Visit **Voteldaho.gov** to request an absentee ballot by **May 10 at 5 p.m.**

Return your ballot by mail or to an election's drop box by **8 p.m. on May 21.**
