Re: Results of Recount, Ada County Commissioner, District 3, May 17, 2016 Primary Election

On Thursday, June 16, 2016, pursuant to a Recount Order issued by the Attorney General, ballots for the Republican Primary Election for County Commissioner, District 3, Ada County, Idaho, were recounted under my supervision. The following happened:

Pursuant to Idaho Code § 34-2313(2), 100 ballots from Precinct 1413 and 101 ballots from Precinct 2211 were counted by hand (not all ballots that were recounted voted for a candidate for County Commissioner, District 3). The results were:

Candidate	Precinct 1413	Precinct 2211	Total
Case	39	48	87
Ullman	50	42	92

These hand-counted ballots were then tabulated by machine. The machine count results were:

Candidate	Precinct 1413	Precinct 2211	Total
Case	39	48	87
Ullman	49	42	91

The discrepancy between the hand count and machine count was 1 vote. Accordingly, the ballots in Precincts 1406, 1413, 1501, 2101, 2207 and 2211, which were the precincts in which the recount was requested, were machine counted. See Idaho Code § 34-2313.

The results of the recount of Precincts 1406, 1413, 1501, 2101, 2207 and 2211 compared to the original results reported was as follows:

No votes shifted between the election night count for these precincts and the recount for these precincts. Accordingly, the results of the recount for these precincts do not require a recount of the remaining Ada County precincts and do not change the outcome of the election.
