The Idaho Supreme Court's June 25, 2021 Amended Order Re: Emergency Order Regarding Court Services provides:

Jury proceedings, including jury trials and grand jury proceedings, may commence anytime during a calendar week unless the Administrative District Judge has determined that the county in which the prospective juror has been summoned to attend court has a seven-day moving average incidence rate of confirmed or presumed cases of COVID-19 of 25.0 or greater per 100,000 population as reflected on the Cases by County page of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare's COVID-19 Data Dashboard available at www.coronavirus.idaho.gov[.]¹

The Administrative District Judge's determination described in this paragraph shall be based on the weekly COVID-19 incident rates for that county published ten (10) days prior to the calendar week in which the jury trial is scheduled to occur. *Id.* at 3-4.

This order utilizes the data issued at the end of business on Thursday, July 1, 2021, when the daily state and county COVID-19 case numbers were released on-line by the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare, for each of the counties in this district, as noted hereinafter.

^{1&}quot;Once a trial has commenced, it should continue to verdict unless, in the discretion of the assigned judge, a significant increase in the weekly COVID-19 incidence rate or other local COVID-19 incident or public health action justifies a temporary suspension of the trial. Any order in this regard must be supported with written findings." Idaho Supreme Court's June 25, 2021 Amended Order Re: Emergency Order Regarding Court Services, at 4.

1. Ada County

Ada County had a seven-day moving COVID-19 case average of 3.9 per 100,000 population. As of this date, Ada County may continue with jury trials, until further notice. Further, neither social distancing or masks will be required in Ada County Court facilities beginning July 6, 2021 and continuing until further order of the Administrative District Judge.

2. Boise County

Boise County had a seven-day moving COVID-19 case average of 7.3 per 100,000 population. As of this date, Boise County may continue with jury trials, until further notice. Further, neither social distancing or masks will be required in Boise County Court facilities beginning July 6, 2021 and continuing until further order of the Administrative District Judge.

3. Elmore County

Elmore County had a seven-day moving COVID-19 case average of 1.6 per 100,000 population. As of this date, Elmore County jury trials may continue with jury trials, until further notice. Further, neither social distancing or masks will be required in Elmore County Court facilities beginning July 6, 2021 and continuing until further order of the Administrative District Judge.

4. Valley County

Valley County had a seven-day moving COVID-19 case average of 7.5 per 100,000 population. As of this date, Valley County may continue with jury trials, until further notice. Further, neither social distancing or masks will be required in Valley County

Court facilities beginning July 6, 2021 and continuing until further order of the Administrative District Judge.

Notwithstanding this Order, upon a finding of good cause and consistent with the Idaho Supreme Court's June 25, 2021 Amended Order Re: Emergency Order Regarding Court Services, a presiding Fourth District Judge may order that participants in a court proceeding socially distance and/or wear masks.
