EXPO Idaho Horse Barn Demo

This is an ARPA designated project.

A part of the Expo Idaho Property is bordered by the Boise River to the North. Many years ago, the horse stables were built in an area designated as the floodway of the Boise River. The horse stables are deteriorating, and in an effort to protect the Boise River from a potential hazard in a flood event and from nonpoint source pollution, the County has determined that the horse stables need to be removed from the property. Once the horse stables are removed, native grasses will be planted to prevent erosion. This Project is being funded by federal monies available to the County through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. Specifically, the Project is being supported, in whole or in part, by federal award number SLFRP3408 awarded to Ada County, Idaho by the U.S. Department of the Treasury.
