EXPO Idaho Park Development

This is an ARPA designated project.

The Project is located on approximately 88 acres of Expo Idaho property, located at 5610 N. Glenwood Street, Boise, Idaho 83714. The property includes a flood consideration zone and the former horse racing facility. Ada County envisions the development of a park in the area to serve underserved neighborhoods and would serve as a community park. Ada County envisions green space, tree cover, gathering spaces, playing fields, recreation facilities, and safe sidewalks, away from traffic, for walking and nonmotorized cycling. At the same time, Ada County is seeking a design that does not negatively impact the Boise River, but instead would utilize this natural feature as an integral part of the park. This Project is being funded by federal monies available to the County through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. Specifically, the Project is being supported, in whole or in part, by federal award number SLFRP3408 awarded to Ada County, Idaho by the U.S. Department of the Treasury.
