JUVENILE DETENTION OUTDOOR RECREATION AREA

This is an ARPA designated project.

ACJS currently has limited outdoor recreation space, and the pandemic has emphasized the lack of outdoor recreation opportunities available to juvenile detainees. The primary goal of this Project is to expand and improve the available green space, to add a new basketball court, and to add a permanent shade canopy. Additional considerations at the proposed site location for canopy would include, sewer line relocation, security fencing (with “anti-climb” material), security cameras, door controls, lighting, and landscaping. Creating a more aesthetically pleasing and positive environment is a secondary goal of the Project. This Project is being funded by federal monies available to the County through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. Specifically, the Project is being supported, in whole or in part, by federal award number SLFRP3408 awarded to Ada County, Idaho by the U.S. Department of the Treasury.
