PSB Elevator Modernization

OVERVIEW

The elevator is original to the Public Safety Building and has been in place since 1975. The elevator can access 3 floors – the basement, vestibule, and the main floor. The elevator opens on two (2) sides. The expected work will include an analysis of the elevators to identify which components require replacement or refurbishment. The County's goal is to increase the longevity of the current elevator systems and to stay within the Idaho elevator code and safety requirements. The scope should include removal and disposal of elevator components not being used in the modernization, the supply and installation of new components, refurbishment of components, electrical work, minimum one-year warranty, one-year full maintenance contract, value engineering (VE) review, and all other work necessary to provide fully functional State of Idaho certified elevators. The successful contractor will also coordinate with the Ada County Information Technology Department for access controls and the County's fire alarm vendor for any required fire alarm initiating devices per NFPA 72 standards.
