CURRENT DUTIES REGARDING EVIDENCE ANALYSIS

- I process evidence from law enforcement personnel in an attempt to develop and identify latent fingerprints and footwear / tire tread impressions.
- I determine the proper chemical processes and sequences in which they should be used for each item of evidence that I process.
- I use photography and digital imaging for the preservation and enhancement of impression evidence.
- I document fingerprints of deceased persons.
- I respond to and process crime scenes for forensic evidence.
- I make comparisons and identifications of latent or unknown impressions with known or inked impressions.
- I maintain the chain of custody, mark, document, and generate reports for said evidence.

- I make charts and exhibits, and testify in court proceedings when called.
- I analyze plant material or residue for marijuana or the resins thereof.
