AT A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ADA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, STATE OF IDAHO, ON THE 23rd DAY OF JUNE, 2020, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 39-2609(4) makes it unlawful for any person to use fireworks in an area that constitutes a severe fire threat based on the vegetative conditions during the current fire season as determined by the county commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners passed Ordinance No. 760, which became effective August 28, 2010, to provide for a ban on the use of fireworks in areas which constitute a severe fire threat; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 760 authorizes a determination by the Board of Ada County Commissioners, before or during the fire season, that a severe fire threat exists; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 760 further provides that the area that will be subject to county enforcement of the fireworks ban pursuant to Idaho Code § 39-2612 will be depicted on a map to be attached to the yearly resolution, if any.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Board of Ada County Commissioners deems it appropriate under the current conditions to declare a severe fire threat sufficient to institute a fireworks ban during the current fire season in the areas shown on the attached map that is made a part hereof.
