



Ada County is the largest county by population in Idaho, home to approximately **27%** of the state's population.

Ada County is more than 1000 square miles of high desert beauty, peppered with foothills and a glistening river that winds through urban and rural landscapes.

Ada County includes Idaho's capital city, **Boise**, and is home to five other distinct municipalities – **Star, Eagle, Meridian, Garden City and Kuna**.

The county is known for a rich agricultural heritage and open spaces for recreation. Ada County's Barber Park is the put-in location for one of the region's most popular activities – the Boise River Float. Ada County is also the state's commerce and industry hub. Expo Idaho in Ada County hosts the annual Western Idaho Fair, one of the biggest and most popular events each year in Southwest Idaho.
